






1. Remove contents from box, verify if all parts listed are present and free from damage. Carefully read and understand all instructions before attempting installation.

Failure to identify damage before installation could lead to a rejection of any claim.



- 2. Begin by removing the plastic trim fasteners holding the grille in place. Also dethatch the clips of the wings of the grille. See **Figures 1 & 2.**
- 3. Remove the grille by pulling firmly and carefully at the bottom of the grille.







- 4. Remove the 4 bolts behind the plastic cover securing the bumper to the vehicle. See **Figure 3.**
- 5. Remove the bolts on the bottom of the frame securing the bumper supports to the vehicle. See **Figure 4.**
- 6. Unplug any wire connections and remove the bumper.





- 7. If reusing the factory fog lights, remove them from the OEM Bumper. If aftermarket lights will be used, install them at this time and move to **Step 9**.
- 8. Using Items 6-9 and supplied M6 hardware, reinstall the fog lights on to the Bandit bumper. **See Figure 5-6**. **Note:** Fog light brackets "A" and "B" belong to the driver side while fog light brackets "C" and "D" belong to the passenger side
- 9. If equipped, reinstall sensors on to the HDX Bandit bumper. *Note:* A separate parts kit will need to be purchased in order to install parking sensors. Refer to PN 58-30005 for instructions.









- 10. Install the mounting brackets onto the frame using supplied M10 hardware. You will use the factory welded M10 nuts to mount the brackets **See Figure 7-8.**
- 11. Install the Support brackets on to the frame and main brackets using supplied M10 and M12 hardware. *Note: 1* You will have to slide the bolt/nut plate through the exposed hole in the frame in order to install support brackets. *Note 2:* Be sure to install nut plate with the M12 bolt side facing towards the front of the vehicle. See Figures 9-11.














12. With help, lift the HDX Bumper (1) into place between the Mount Brackets (2,3) and attach with supplied M12 Hardware. **See Figure 12. CAUTION:** The HDX Bandit Bumper is very heavy. The use of a floor jack or hoist is recommended.





- 13. Install the two license plate grommets as shown in **Figure 13** and install license plate using OEM hardware.
- 14. Trim the inner fender as desired. See Figure 14.
- 15. Align and adjust the bumper as necessary. Once the desired fit is achieved, torque all hardware as specified: torque M10 Hardware to 30-35 ft-lbs, M12 to 45-50 ft-lbs.








CARE INSTRUCTIONS
