

PROCEDURE


1. Remove contents from box, verify if all parts listed are present and free from damage. Carefully read and understand all instructions before attempting installation.


Failure to identify damage before installation could lead to a rejection of any claim.




- 2. Remove stock bumper
 - a. Open the hood of the vehicle and remove the plastic cover at the front using a pry tool. See **Figure 1**.
 - b. Remove the four bolts holding the grill in place and uninstall the grill. See **Figure 2**.
 - c. Remove the braces on each side of the vehicle by removing the bolts indicated in **Figure 3**.
 - d. Disconnect all electrical connections to the stock bumper.
 - e. Remove the two bolts indicated in **Figure 4** on the driver's side of the vehicle. Repeat procedure on the passenger's side.
 - f. Remove stock bumper. See Figure 5.












- 3. Use the supplied M10 Hardware to attach each Side Pod Assembly (1,2) to the Center Section (3). See **Figure 6.**
- 4. Use the supplied M6 Hardware to attach the LED Brackets (15) to the center section. See **Figure 7.** *Note: If installing an LED Light Bar (sold separately), install it at this time.*



5. Loosely install the bumper assembly to the Mounting Brackets (6,7) using the supplied M12 Hardware. See **Figures 8 & 9.**







PARKING SENSOR INSTALLATION

*If not installing sensors, install Hole Plugs (20) into holes on bumper and proceed


- 6. Remove the parking sensors from the OEM bumper.
- 7. Use the Sensor Tab (14) along with the supplied M6 Hardware (33,34) to install the sensors as shown in **Figure 10.**
- 8. Make sure to maintain stock sensor orientation.
- 9. Handle sensors with care as they are fragile.




- 8. Loosely attach the preassembled bumper to the vehicle frame using the Factory Hardware. See Figure 11.
- 9. Loosely attach the L-Support Brackets (8,9) to the vehicle's frame. See Figure 12.




10. Use the supplied M8 and M10 Hardware to secure both the Side Straps (10,11) and Outer Support Straps (16,17) to the bumper and L-Brackets. See **Figure 13.**




11. Attach the Mesh Side Covers (5) to the Bumper using the supplied M6 Hardware. See Figures 14 & 15.





- 12. Attach the supplied M8 U-Clips (38) to the bumper. See **Figure 16.** *Note: If using the Outlaw Skid Plate (sold separately), skip this skid plate install.*
- 13. Use the factory tow hook hardware to attach the Valance Mounting Brackets (12,13). See **Figure 17.**





- 14. Install the Skid Plate to the bumper using the supplied M8 Hardware. See Figure 18.
- 15. Secure the Skid Plate (4) to the Valance Mounting Brackets using the supplied M8 and M10 Hardware. See Figure 19.
- 15. Align bumper as desired and tighten hardware as specified: M6 to 7 ft-lbs, M8 to 18 ft-lbs, M10 to 38 ft-lbs, M12 to 60 ft-lbs
- 16. If installing lower skid plate P#58-71005, use items 18 and 19 to mount skid tube brackets to frame. See Figure 20 below.


