

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REMOVE CONTENTS FROM BOX. VERIFY ALL PARTS ARE PRESENT. READ INSTRUCTIONS CAREFULLY BEFORE STARTING INSTALLATION. BUMPER IS HEAVY, ASSISTANCE IS HIGHLY RECOMMENDED. CUTTING MAY BE REQUIRED.

- 1. Remove the license plate. On models with bumper mounted sensors and/or fog lights, unplug the wiring harness leading to the front bumper. Move the wiring harnesses out of the way.




(Fig 1) Locate and remove driver/left side bumper bracket to frame hardware (arrows)


(Fig 2) Bumper removed. Tow hooks pictured removed for instruction purposes only, it is not necessary to remove tow hooks

- 2. Locate the factory bumper bolts attaching the inner bumper brackets to the end of the frame, (Figure 1). With assistance, remove the (2) long hex bolts per side to remove the bumper assembly, (Figure 2). WARNING! Assistance is required to hold the bumper in place during hardware removal to prevent the bumper from falling.
- 3. Slide the factory bumper off over the tow hooks, (Figure 2).
- 4. Remove the lower frame extensions, (optional), if equipped, from the bottom of the frame, (Figure 2).


(Fig 4) Frame Brackets installed

- **5.** Select (1) Frame Bracket. Line up the holes in the Bracket with the outside of the driver/left side of the frame. Reuse the (2) factory long hex bolts to attach the Bracket to the frame, **(Figures 3 & 4)**.
- 6. Repeat Steps 5 & 6 to attach the passenger/right side Mounting Bracket, (Figure 4).




(Fig 5) Remove harness and parking sensors from factory bumper if equipped

- 7. Carefully remove all sensors and the wiring harness from the back of the OE bumper, (Figure 5). Note location of each sensor for correct reinstallation.

Models without bumper sensors:

- a. Select the included (6) Plastic Plugs.
- b. Push the plugs into the sensor mounting holes, (Figure 6).


Models with bumper mounted sensors. NOTE: Sensors, (if equipped), must be installed in Bumper before Bumper is attached to Brackets:


(Fig 7) Remove front seal from Sensor. Apply larger Foam Seal to sensor. Slide sensor into sleeve, insert Foam Spacer and Retaining Cap to lock sensor in sleeve

- **a.** Select the driver/left outer sensor. Remove the seal from the end of the sensor, **(Figure 7)**. Replace the seal with the included larger Foam Seal.
- **b.** Push the sensor into the mounting socket in the back of the Bumper.
- c. Apply (1) Foam Spacer to the plug end of the sensor, (Figure 7).
- d. Secure the sensor to the socket with (1) Sensor Retaining Cap, (Figure 7).
- **e.** Move to the next sensor location. Repeat previous Steps to install the next sensor as you work your way across the Bumper.
- **f.** Reinstall the factory wiring harness. **NOTE**: (2) Wire Harness Extensions have been included. It may be necessary to reach the outer sensors as needed. sensors.
- **g.** Secure harness to the Bumper as required.
- **8.** Optional Center LED light installation, (light not included). NOTE: Light may be easier to install in Bumper before Bumper Assembly is attached to the Brackets.




(Fig 8) Attach Left/Right LED Brackets to tabs on back of Bumper (right side illustrated)




(Fig 9) Example of center light installation

 - a. Select the L/R "L" Brackets, (Figure 8). NOTE: "L" Brackets are offset for universal fitment for most LED bar style lights. Attach the LED light assembly to the "L" Brackets with the included (2) 8mm x 16mm Hex Bolts, (2) 8mm Lock Washers and (2) 8mm Flat Washers, (Figures 8 & 9). Do not fully tighten hardware at this time. NOTE: "L" Brackets may require modification for hardware larger than 8mm or use brackets supplied with light if possible.
 - **b.** Attach the light and brackets to the top of the (2) tabs on the back of the Bumper with the included 8mm x 25mm Hex Bolts, (4) 8mm Flat Washers, (2) 8mm Lock Washers and (2) 8mm Hex Nuts, **(Figures 8 & 9)**. Adjust light position and tighten hardware.
 - **c.** Follow light manufacturer's instructions to wire the light to the vehicle's electrical system once Bumper has been fully installed.
- 9. Accessory Light Installation (optional-light available separately):




(Fig 10) Remove covers and reuse hardware to attach light (light available separately)

 - a. Remove cover from the driver/left side of the Bumper, (Figure 10).
 - **b.** Reuse the hardware to attach accessory light to mounting holes in Bumper. **NOTE**: Bumper is designed for surface mount style light installation only.
 - **c.** Repeat previous Steps to install passenger/right side light.
 - **d.** Follow instructions supplied with lights to attach to vehicle electrical system.
- **10.** With assistance, position the Bumper assembly up to the (2) Frame Brackets. **WARNING**: To avoid possible injury or damage to the vehicle, do not proceed until the Bumper is fully and safely supported.
- **11.** Attach the Bumper to the Frame Brackets with (8) 10mm x 35mm Hex Bolts, (16) 10mm Flat Washers and (8) 10mm Nylon Lock Nuts, **(Figure 11)**. Snug but do not fully tighten hardware.
- **12.** Level and adjust the Bumper to the vehicle and tighten all hardware.
- 13. If front license plate is required, attach the License Plate Bracket to the holes in the Bumper with the included (2) 6mm x 20mm Button Head Bolts, (4) 6mm Flat Washers and (2) 6mm Nylon Lock Nuts, (Figure 12). Insert (2) Plastic Plugs into the square holes in the Bracket. Reuse the factory screws to attach the license plate to the Plastic Plugs.
- 14. Do periodic inspections to the installation to make sure that all hardware is secure and tight.


To protect your investment, do not use any type of polish or wax that may contain abrasives that could damage the finish. Mild soap may be used to clean the Bumper Assembly.

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Driver Side Installation Pictured

WARNING! To avoid possible injury or damage to vehicle, do not remove bumper bolts unless the bumper is properly supported on blocks or stands or it may fall.

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

WARNING! Do not crawl under bumper unless it is properly supported on blocks or stands or the bumper may fall.

PRODUCT CARE

- Periodically check the product to ensure all fasteners are tight and components are intact.
- Regular waxing is recommended to protect the finish of the product.
- Use ONLY Non-Abrasive automotive wax. Use of any soap, polish or wax that contains an abrasive is detrimental and can scratch the finish leading to corrosion.
- Mild soap may be used to clean the Black finish product.

FAQ's

1. Hardware and mounting brackets are not aligning properly

Ensure that hardware is being used on the correct side of the vehicle. In some cases, the hardware may appear same for driver or passenger side but may alter the alignment of mounting location. Check mounting brackets for both sides.

2. Bumper is not aligning with vehicle

Bumper Brackets may be interchanged or reversed (Driver / Passenger Side). Check Brackets for each side as well ensure the proper hardware has been used for each side.

3. Products are thumping / rattling after installation.

Ensure that all required mounting brackets / hardware's are installed & tighten correctly. Suggest using white lithium / regular grease between metal to metal contact.

4. Missing / Excess Hardware.

Recheck hardware count as per the part list.

5. Product not installing properly.


Ensure the Year / Make / Model as well as cab and bed dimensions are correct for the application. Review all steps for installation to ensure they were followed correctly.
