Maintenance

Mild automotive detergent may be used to clean the product. Do not use dish detergent, abrasive cleaners, abrasive pads, wire brushes or other similar products that may damage the finish.

Step 1

If reverse sensors are present, remove the sensors from the factory bumper.

Step 2

Unplug the license plate lights and remove the license plate.

Step 3

Unplug the trailer plug and remove it from the bumper.

Step 4

Remove the spare tire release cover.

Step 5

Locate the plastic clips on the bottom side of the bumper and squeeze them together and push up to remove the top plastic part of the bumper. This will uncover the two (2) 13mm bumper bolts on the top of the bumper.

Step 6

Remove three (3) bolts from each side of the back of the bumper, then remove the two 13mm bolts on the top of the bumper exposed in the previous step.

Step 7

Cut off the trailer plug plate that is welded on top of the receiver hitch.



Step 8

Using the black 1/4" button head bolts and kep nuts, bolt the spare tire insert and trailer plug insert to the back side of the bumper. Make sure the round part of the trailer plug insert is to the top.

Step 9

Install the license plate by using the provided ¼" bolts.

Then install the spare tire plug immediately after.

Step 10

Install the Ranch Hand bumper by using the 7/16" bolts, washers, lock washers and nuts.

Step 11

If sensors are present, remove the "knockouts" from the bumper. Install the rubber grommets to hold the sensors in place.

Step 12

Install the license plate lights and splice their wiring into the factory license plate wires.

Step 13

Install the reverse lights and splice their wiring into the truck's reverse light wires.
